TIMELINE

The City of Holland plans to break ground on a Community Bike Park in the spring of 2026.

LOCATION

The Bike Park will be located at 97 N. River Ave, just north of the Unity Bridge.

WHAT IS IT?

The park will initially feature approximately 600 feet of asphalt pump track near a community gathering space. As interest and investment grow, additional trails and features will be added.
